

# Various Ways that Doctors Properly Diagnose Hemorrhoids

**H**emorrhoids are veins that can be noticed in a person's anus. These types of veins stimulate pain, burning sensations, and bleeding in individuals when they have been applied or are swollen.

Several individuals will determine that they are having problems with their hemorrhoids when they see blood in the toilet, feel the large of veins while they're wiping themselves after they have had a bowel movement, or will feel the veins sticking out of their anus after they have had a bowel move. Also they are going to feel intense pain and a burning sensation on or around the anus.



Is entirely possible that the symptoms frequently associated with hemorrhoids are actually indicative of another medical condition that is associated with the anus. Other medical conditions that it can be confused with include; fissures, perianal, fistulae, infections, tumors, and also skin diseases. In order to prognosis the proper condition doctors will execute specific tests.

External hemorrhoids are usually better to diagnosis because they are outside of the anus and can easily be recognized. Internal hemorrhoids are much more challenging to prognosis because they are inside of the anus. The doctor may execute a rectal examination making use of their gloved finger to look for the swollen hemorrhoid deep inside of the anus. Yet, in order to be more exact they might use an anoscope examination.

- Anoscopes is often a tapering three inch long clear plastic or metal hollow tube that is one inch in diameter.
- The doctor will lube it prior to applying it into the anus from the anal canal and into the rectum.
- When it is being taken away the doctor will be able to distinguish the internal hemorrhoids.
- In the event that the patient is straining it will make them more visual.

## Indirect Anoscopy May Also be Applied to Identify Hemorrhoids

The physician will use a special mirror to help begin to see the patient's anus better while they are sitting down and also straining while on the toilet. During this procedure the doctor will be able to see the results that the straining is having on the patient's anus. This will also make it simpler so they can see any lumps that could be recognized as hemorrhoids.
